

MEDLOCK PRIMARY SCHOOL

In Autumn Term 2, Year 1 will be learning about houses and homes.

Communication, Language, Literacy

The children will continue to develop their language skills through exploring the continuous provision. We will be developing talk through daily class discussions e.g. talking about seasons and weather. If needed the children will also be taking part in Wellcomm interventions. This will support their understanding of spoken word. The children will also be taking part in weekly guided Reading sessions.

Literacy Development

We will start the term by exploring non-fiction texts, we will look at the differences between fiction and non-fiction, then we will write our own non-chronological report. We will also create our own narratives looking at the key features of setting description. As always, we will spend time exploring poetry.

Mathematical Development.

We will continue to be focusing on numbers up to 20. This will include counting knowing one more and one less than any number from 1-20, doubling and halving and addition and subtraction. We also be exploring shape and pattern.

Theme

We will continue to explore houses through different subjects. In History we will looking at how houses have changed over time. In Geography we will be exploring our local area. We will also be learning about UK animals and their habitats.

Art and DT

In art we will be exploring houses through printing, using natural materials, drawing and collage. Through DT the children will be learning about different structures and the features of houses. They will choose suitable materials and how to fix them together.

Physical Development

We will have specialist PE coaching this term. This will focus on developing the children's throwing and catching skills. We will have opportunities to further this development in our Year One outdoor area. We will continue to build on developing the children's fine motor skills to help support their writing.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term our PSE focus is how to understand their own feelings and other people's feelings. We will also be teaching the NSPCC lessons about 'Speak Out Stay Safe'
